



## Potsdam Junior Hockey Game Day Protocol 2020-2021 Season

EACH day that you or your child comes to Pine Street Arena (43 Pine Street, Potsdam), we ask that you follow this protocol:

PJHA appreciates your support, honesty and understanding of the PJHA COVID-19 Mitigation Plan.

Prior to coming to Pine Street Arena, please print and complete PJHA COVID Health Screening Questionnaire. Be sure to take the temperature of player and spectator (1) within 2 hours of game time. Temperatures must be below 100.4°F, and participant & spectator must BOTH answer NO to all questions on health screening questionnaire. (Only 1 form required for participant & their 1 spectator.)

\*1 spectator allowed per participant. \*Masks must be worn at all times, by participants & spectators

\*PJHA Parent Volunteer(s) will meet you at the door to collect questionnaires & assist with PJHA Game Day Protocols - no sooner than 10 minutes before game time.

YES TO ANY QUESTION

DRESS APPROPRIATELY BEFORE COMING TO THE RINK:

Players: Dress in your hockey gear, other than helmet and skates.  
WEAR YOUR FACE MASK.

Parents/Spectators: You are required to WEAR A FACE MASK the entire time that you are inside the arena.

BE SURE BRING YOUR OWN WATER BOTTLE.

If you answer YES to any of these questions, please **STAY HOME**. Our communities thank you for your honesty!

WAIT IN YOUR CAR until 10 minutes before the game starts

ENTER through the correct door:

- All players and spectators of the VISITING team will enter the door closest from Pine Street. (Left end of the building as you face it)
- The HOME team will enter on the snack bar end (Door on the right)

GO IMMEDIATELY TO YOUR ASSIGNED SEATS:

- \*It is the responsibility of the player/parent to clean seating areas before and after use.\* \*Bring your own sanitizing spray or wipes.\*
- Players should go directly to their assigned seats (must match the number on the roster provided by your coach) and put on their skates and helmets. Players must keep their helmets on during the game.
- Parents/spectators may help their player get ready, if needed, and should then proceed to the bleachers and stay on an X. **Spectators are not permitted to stand near the glass or in open areas. Spectators that do not stay socially distanced on an X in the bleachers with their masks in place will be asked to leave the building.** (Be sure to put trash in the proper receptacles.)

### SAFETY RULES

1. Masks must be worn at all times while in the arena, this includes players, coaches, referees, volunteers, and spectators.
2. Social distancing must be maintained. Parents and players are not allowed to move within 6 feet of each other except for incidental touches during play.
3. Assigned seats MUST be utilized so that we are able to report appropriately for contact tracing should a case occur.
4. **The warm room is closed.**

THE GAME

- Players must stay in their assigned seat until instructed by their coach to enter the ice.
- Masks may only be removed if the player is 6 feet from all other people and only for drinking purposes or for health emergencies.
- Only incidental contact is allowed during games.

AFTER THE GAME

- If your child needs assistance removing equipment, please make your way to your child's assigned seat when skaters begin to leave the ice. All other spectators are asked to leave the arena immediately following the game.
- Skaters should go immediately to their assigned seat after leaving the ice
- Only remove your gloves, skates, and helmet while inside the building.
- Sanitize your seat
- Leave through the same door you entered
